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MINUTES Board Meeting Friday, June 10, 2011

The Alabama Board of Massage Therapy met on Friday, June 10, 2011, at the Board Office, located at 610 S. McDonough Street, Montgomery, Alabama, in order to conduct business. The following members were in attendance: Mr. Michael Stephens, Chair, Mr. Lance Gilliland, Ms. Gwen Motley, and Mr. Foad Araiinejad. Members not in attendance were Mr. Willie DeVold and Ms. Angel Stacey. Also in attendance were Mr. Keith E. Warren (Executive Director), Mr. Bill Garrett (Board Counsel), Mr. Randy Barrows (Executive Assistant) and Ms. Renee' Reames (Executive Assistant to Mr. Warren). A quorum was established and the meeting was called to order at 10:07 a.m.

The Board unanimously approved the expense reports submitted by Board members present at the meeting.

Ms. Motley made a motion to approve the new applications for Massage Therapist licenses as presented (list attached). The motion was seconded by Mr. Gilliland and unanimously approved by the Board.

Mr. Gilliland made a motion to approve the applications for Massage Therapy Instructor licenses as presented (list attached). The motion was seconded by Ms. Motley and unanimously approved by the Board.

Ms. Motley made a motion to approve the applications for Massage Therapy School renewal applications as presented to the Board (list attached). The motion was seconded by Mr. Araiinejad and unanimously approved by the Board.

Ms. Motley made a motion to approve the Continuing Education Provider applications as presented (list attached). The motion was seconded by Mr. Araiinejad and unanimously approved by the Board.

Mr. Warren reported that changes to the statute, introduced by Senator Hubbard, did not pass during this recent legislative session. The Board agreed to begin working on legislative issues, to include Reflexology, in advance of the next legislative session.

The Board discussed state representation on NCBTMB, Ms. Motley indicated that ethics continuing education training is required by NCBTMB and recommended that the Board consider providing this training.

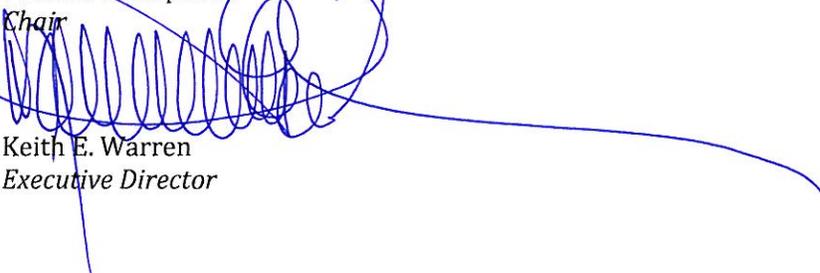
The next regularly scheduled Board meeting is July 22, 2011 at 10:00 a.m.
